2016 Fonda Fair Camping Rules & Regulations

The following rules apply to trailers, motor homes & camping units for housing, tents & special services.

PERMITS:

1) A camping permit must be secured from the Fonda Fair prior to parking your unit. The parking area will be designated and assigned at the time of payment. All camping units parked during the fair must prominently display this permit in a window. Permits will be sent to you via mail/email, or can be picked up from Betty Kilcullen, (site #50, cell: 518-848-8691) if final payment is due (CASH ONLY) before parking your unit. The Fonda Fair Board of Managers reserves the right to cancel any permits at any time for due cause or repeated violations.

2) Parking spaces are limited and the Fair Managers will not guarantee a parking spot when all space has been allocated. Parking of your motor vehicles will not be allowed in the campgrounds.

SANATION and FIRE REGULATIONS:

1) All individuals are required to comply with the State and County Health Departments Regulations. All units are subject to inspection by the State & County Health Departments. Violators of any State or County Health Codes are subject to prosecution under Section #229 or #248 of the New York State Public Health Law.

2) No sewage or wastewater will be dumped on the ground surface or in holes dug by trailer owners. All waste must be contained in holding tanks. The dumping stations MUST be used to empty all gray wastewater and sewage tanks.

3) Each water house connection MUST have an anti-backflow device even if connected with a "Y". This is a NYS Health Dept. Regulation. Water connectors shall be tight & comply with NYS Codes. Leaking connectors will be disconnected. (Village water pressure may necessitate the use of pressure reduction connectors.) Back flow valves must remain on the faucets.

4) Each individual is responsible to maintain his/her immediate area in a clean and sanitary condition. All trash and refuse must be deposited daily in refuse containers.

5) All electrical connections must plug into existing outlets. NO direct wiring without permission from a certified Fonda Fair electrician. No one is to unplug another camper. No one is to tamper with or dismantle electrical boxes.

6) No open flame (fire, bonfire) allowed in entire camp area. Gas grills may be used in a designated area.

7) All units shall have enough space around the unit to allow for emergency personnel if necessary. Each unit must maintain a 5" perimeter around the entire unit. This includes slide outs and awnings. The NYS regulations require that there must be 10" from all other camping units. This includes TENTS.

8) All animals housed in the camping units must be caged or tied when outside the camping unit. No animals are allowed on the midway or in buildings except for seeing-eye dogs. All messes are to be cleaned up.

9) All grills & camp stoves, in use or not, must be 10 feet away from campers and awnings & not sitting on tables. 10) No easy ups or tents are allowed between campers

11) No large animals (cattle, horses, sheep, goats, swine, etc.) are allowed in the campground area

12) All gray water tanks, sewer tanks and sewage hoses must be in good condition, with no leaks and may not be patched or wrapped with duct tape.

13) Only one car is permitted in the campground parking area, all other family and/or friends will be required to park in other parking areas.

14) No generators shall be run between 9 pm and 7 am.

The above rules and regulations must be adhered to. Violation of these rules and regulations will result in immediate removal of the camping unit from the fair grounds. The Fonda Fair Board of Managers reserves the right to cancel any permits at any time for due cause or repeated violations.
